- a. ICSE : Girls have done better than Boys, pass percentage is : 99.05%**
Boys have achieved a pass percentage of 98.12%
- ISC : Girls have achieved a pass percentage of 97.84%**
Boys have achieved a pass percentage of 95.40%
- b.** The ICSE examination has been conducted in 60 written subjects of which 22 are Indian languages and 10 are foreign languages and 2 Classical languages.

The ISC examination has been conducted in 49 written subjects of which 14 are Indian languages and 6 are foreign languages and 1 Classical language.

e.1 ICSE – Special Category Statistics

- **9996 Scheduled Caste** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 97.75%
- **6396 Scheduled Tribe** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 97.44%
- **39915 Other Backward Classes** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 98.53%

e.2 ISC – Special Category Statistics

- **3716 Scheduled Caste** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 95.26%
- **3196 Scheduled Tribe** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 93.74%
- **12588 Other Backward Classes** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 96.19%

f.1 ICSE – Special Difficulty Cases

Candidates with Learning difficulty (Dyslexia etc) cases were **1021** (123 candidates obtained above 90%).

Visually Challenged cases were **36** (11 candidates obtained above 90%).

3 candidates took their examinations in the **Hospitals** .

f.2 ISC – Special Difficulty Cases

Candidates with Learning difficulty (Dyslexia etc) cases were **196** (25 candidates obtained above 90%).

Visually Challenged cases were **18** (4 candidates obtained above 90%).
